Quilt Uber-fest block #8

Cut:

- (8) 3" squares from A and B
- (6) 3" squares from C and D
- (1) 2½" x 10½" strip from D
- (1) 2½" x 12½" strip from D

Pair the specified number of each of the following fabrics to make "sets":

- (5) 3" squares from A and B
- (3) 3" squares from A and C
- (3) 3" squares from C and D
- (3) 3" squares from D and B

Using a water-soluble marking pen, mark the diagonal on the back of the lighter square in each set, as shown. Sew 1/4" away from the line on both sides. Cut on marked line. Press toward darker fabric. Trim to 2½" square. Yield 28 Half-Square Triangles (HSTs).

Lay out HSTs according to the block layout diagram. You will have extra HSTs. Sew together rows using a scant ¼" seam. Press seams in alternating directions by row, as shown.

Sew rows together, nesting seams. Press seams toward the top. Square up to 10½" square if necessary. Sew the 2½" x 10½" strip to the top, press toward strip. Sew the 2½" x 12½" strip to the left side. Press toward strip.
